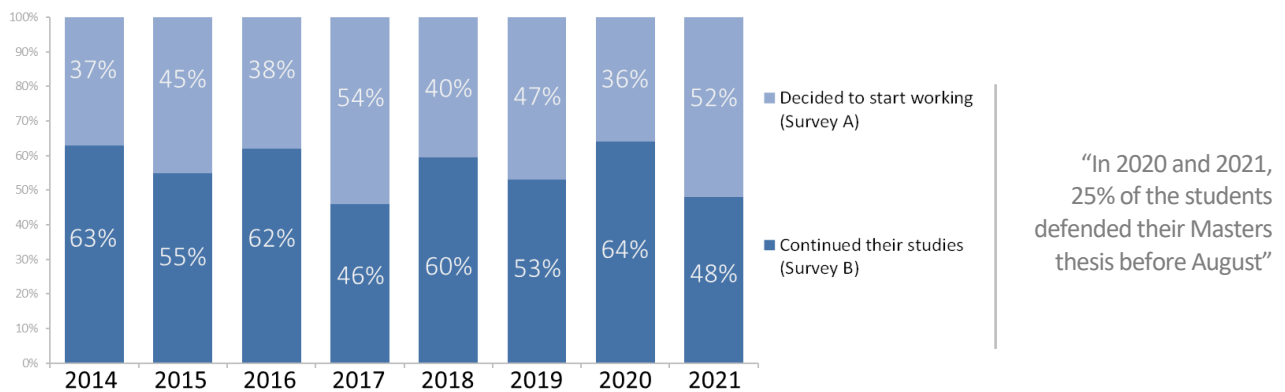

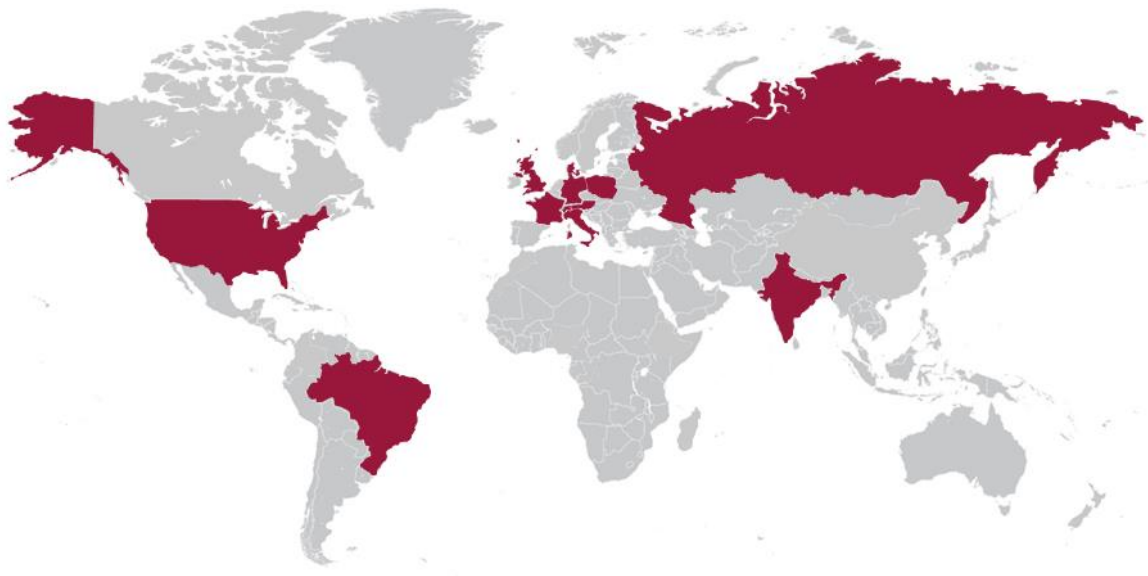
Work versus Study

Overall, at the end of the M2, PSE graduates have:



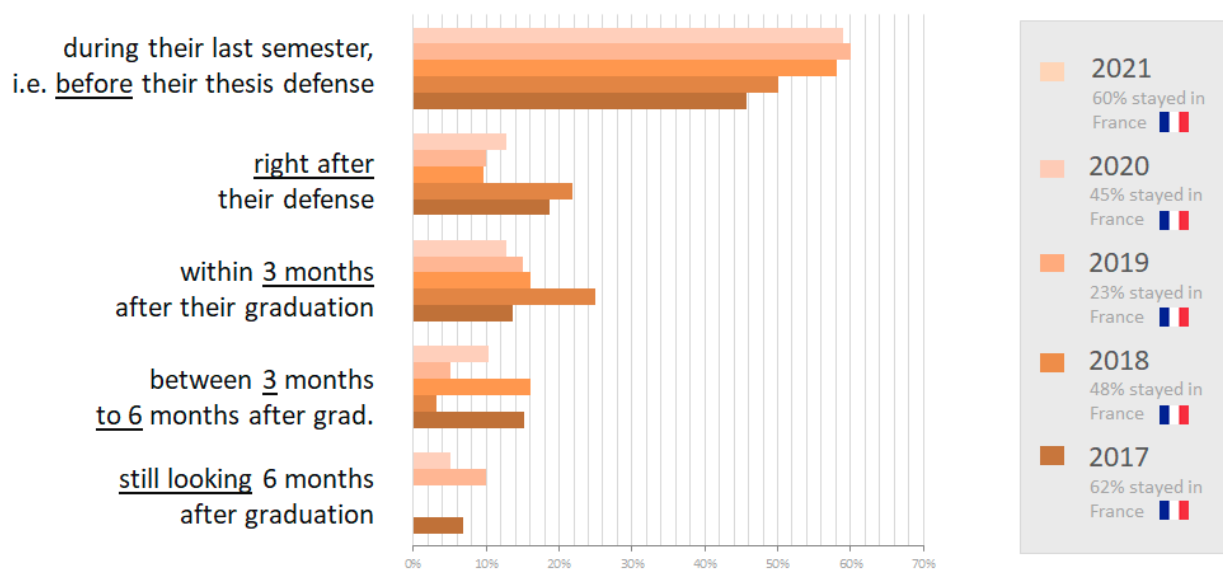
Where do PSE Graduates go?

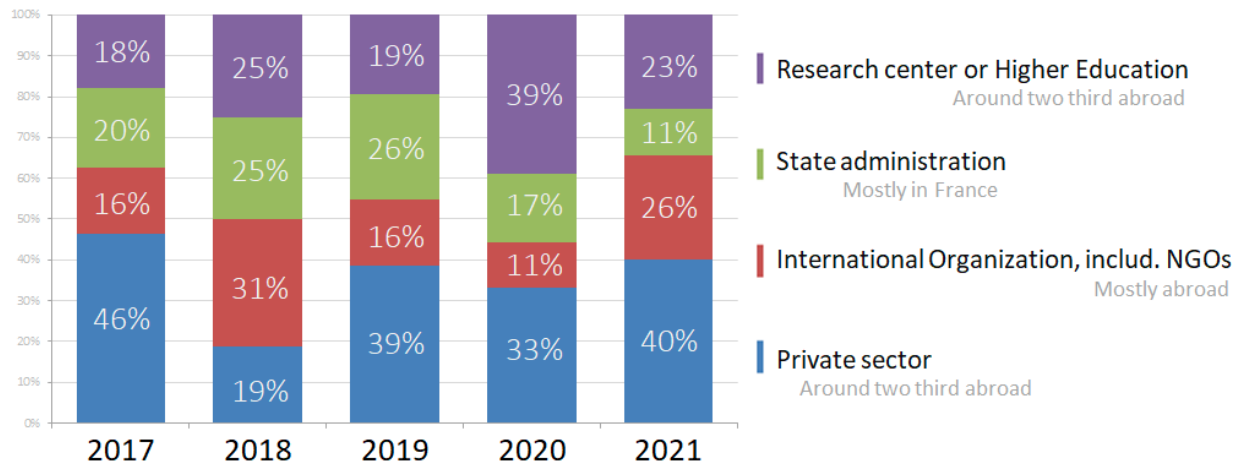

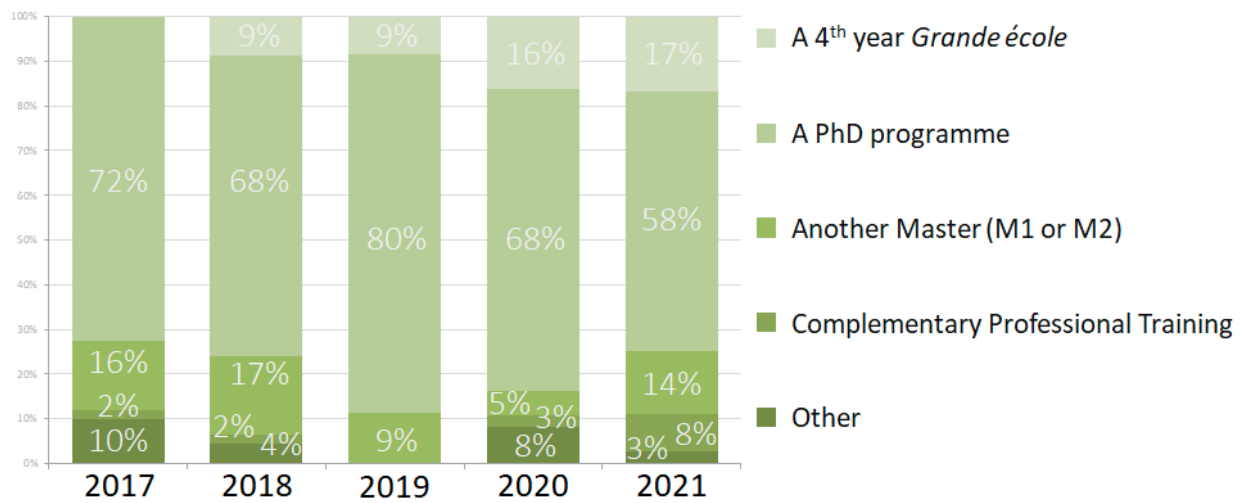
