Travel information

The Paris School of Economics is easily accessible via the two following transport lines:

- From Hôtel B55: 15 min walk to PSE
- From Gare du Nord: Take line RERB southbound (to "Robinson" or "Saint-Rémy-lès-Chevreuse"), stop at "Cité Universitaire" and walk to PSE (10mn);
- From Orly airport: Take the "Orlybus" to "Denfert-Rochereau," then take rail line RERB southbound (to "Robinson" or "Saint-Rémy-lès-Chevreuse"), stop at "Cité Universitaire" and walk to PSE (10mn); Another possibility is to take the "Orlyval" to "Anthony," then take rail line RERB northbound (to "Aéroport CDG"), stop at "Cité Universitaire" and walk to PSE (10mn);
- From CDG-Airport or Gare-du-Nord Station: Take rail line RERB southbound (to "Robinson" or "Saint-Rémy-lès-Chevreuse"), stop at "Cité Universitaire" and walk to PSE (10mn).

RER B: « Cité Universitaire »

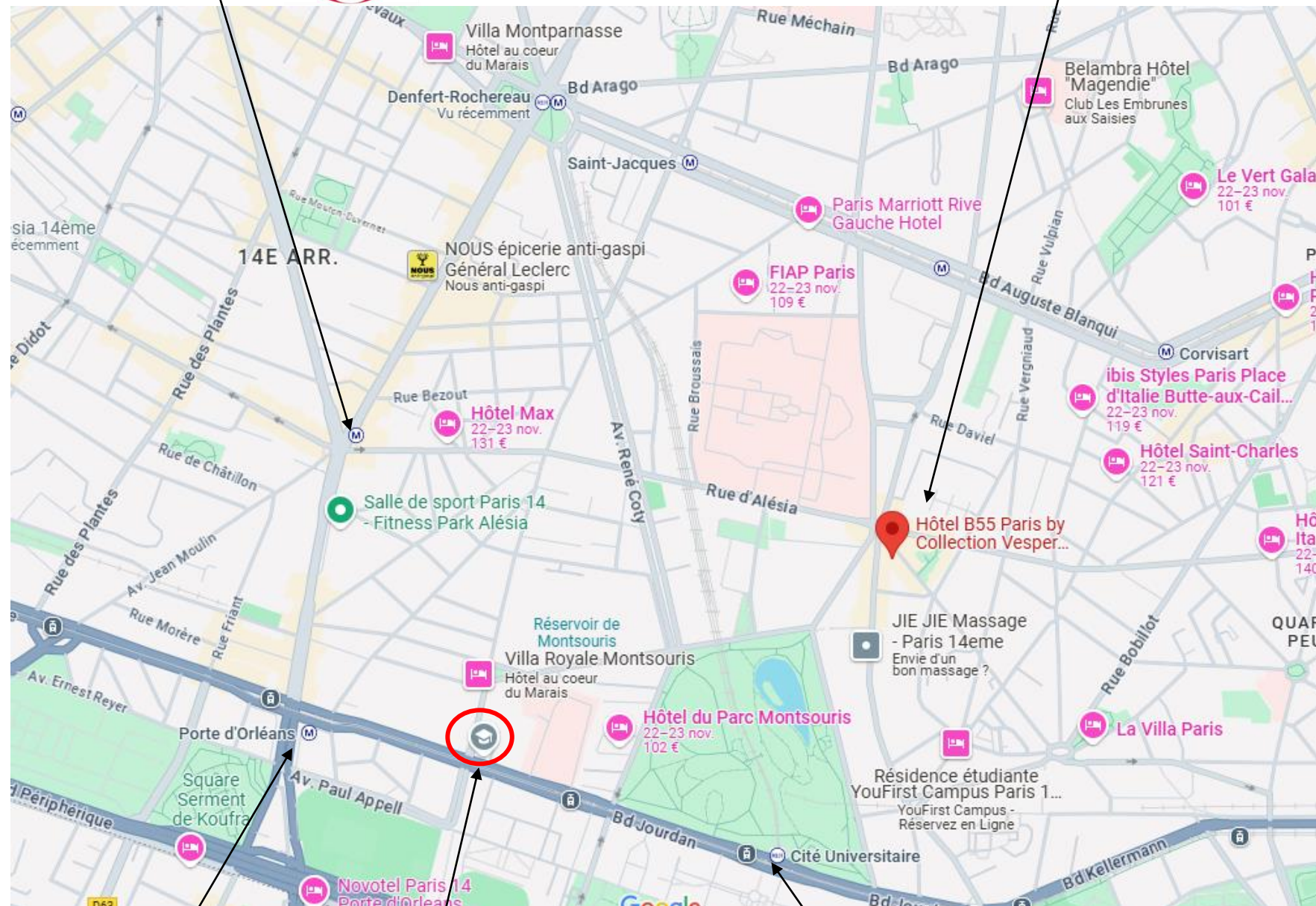
Metro line n°4: Alésia



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Metro n°4 : Porte d'Orléan

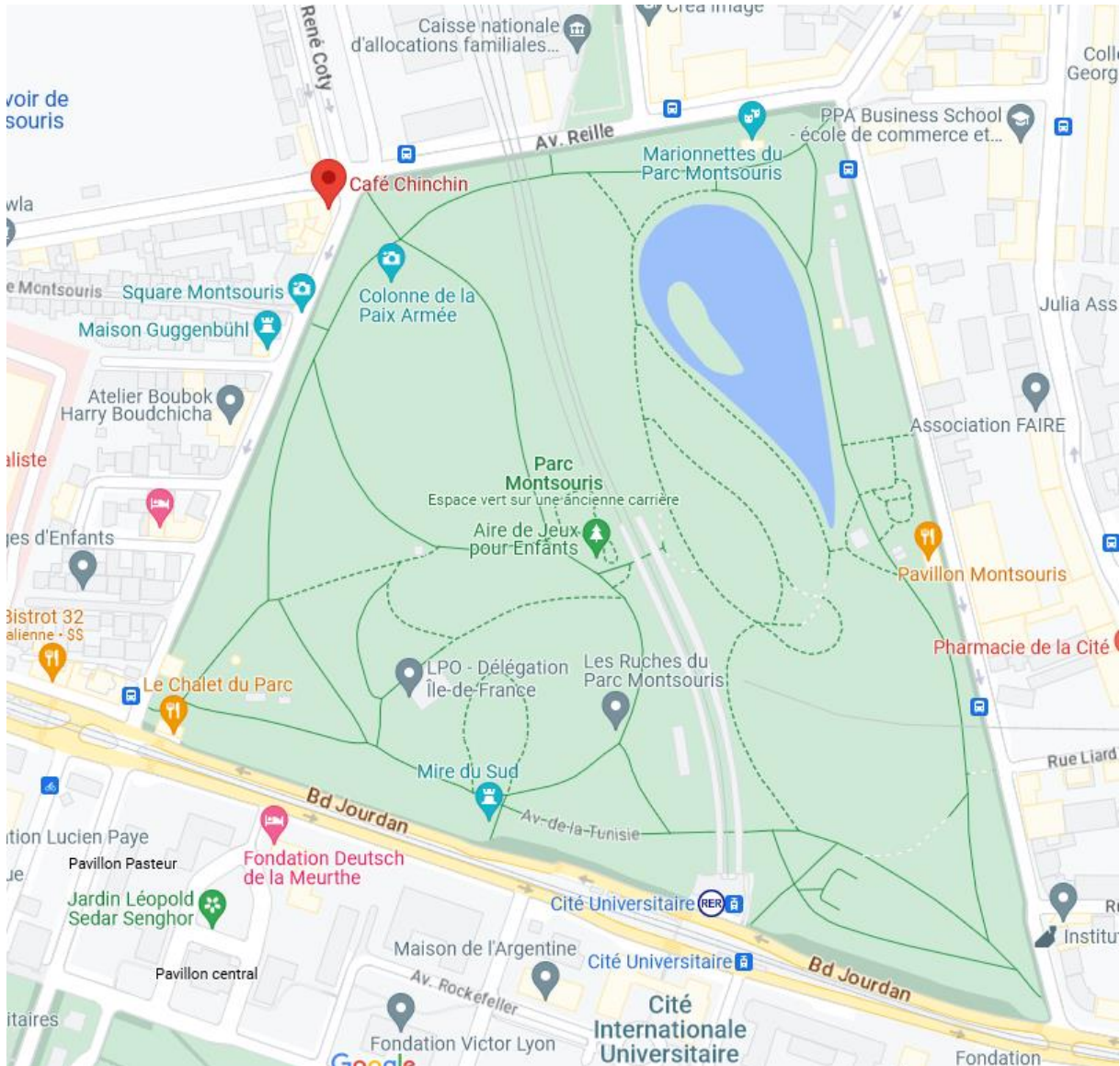
