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

## Work in progress

- **Does later retirement change your health care consumption? Evidence from France**  
Impact of later retirement on health care expenditures. This work use the 1993 pension scheme as an instrumental variable, using administrative data from the national health insurance.

- **Impact of later retirement on mortality: evidence from France** (co-authors: A. Bozio & C. Garrouste)  
Impact of delaying retirement on mortality between age 72 and 76. This paper uses the 1993 pension reform as an exogenous change in claiming age, using administrative data of the private pension scheme (Cnav).
- **Does an increase in formal care affect informal care? Evidence from France** (co-author: Q. Roquebert)  
Impact of an exogenous change in formal care use on informal care consumption. This paper takes advantage of disparities in the price of formal care providers among department, using the french survey on health.
- **Dynamic micro-simulation of elderly disability** (co-authors: M. Ben Jelloul, A. Bozio, A. Rain, L. Toulemon)  
Projection of elderly dependency population on a 5-scales dependency, using Europeans data on health and administrative data on population.

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
